EMBARKING ON THE AQUA MARE

LA1413 / LA1415

LATAM Airlines operates two morning flights (LA1413 / LA1415) which arrive on the day of embarkation on Aqua Mare. Both flights may be boarded in either Quito or Guayaquil. When booking tickets via Aqua Expeditions, the offered flight may vary depending on seasonality and sailing date.

Guests should arrive 2 hours prior to departure to meet our Aqua representatives at the Consejo de Gobierno del Régimen Especial de Galápagos of the respective airports. Our Aqua representatives will assist guests with the purchase of the Transit Control Card (TCC/TCT) that must be presented at the airport check-in counter. The cost of the TCC/TCT is covered by Aqua Expeditions.

To protect the Galapagos' ecosystem, guests aged 18 and above are required to complete an online <u>Declaration Form</u> up to 48 hours prior to their trip.

The Galapagos National Park entry fee will be prepaid by Aqua Expeditions. Upon arrival at Baltra's Seymour Airport, guests should head directly to the VIP lounge (to the right of Immigration Control) where Aqua representatives will assist guests with the Baggage and Customs procedures—which may take up to an hour. Thereafter, guests will be escorted on a shared transfer to Aqua Mare, where our crew will be on hand to assist with luggage retrieval.


7-night East itinerary and 14-night East & West itinerary


